Tai Esgyn Housing was established in 1977 in Swansea to provide accommodation and support upon discharge to patients from a local psychiatric hospital, with the aim of preventing re-admission and promoting independence in the community. The organisation, which became Tai Esgyn Housing in 1999, is both a registered charity and a not-for-profit limited company; any operating surplus is reinvested to develop service provision.

Tai Esgyn is registered with the Welsh Assembly Government as an Approved Support Provider and with the Care and Social Services Inspectorate for Wales as a Domiciliary Care Provider and its services are inspected by these bodies on a regular basis to safeguard standards and ensure quality provision.



Tai Esgyn is able to deliver services across Wales. The organisation currently works with people in four different Local Authority areas and is an Approved Provider in many others.

Tai Esgyn fulfils the role of Managing Agent with a number of Registered Social Landlords across South Wales, providing properties which range from one bedroom flats, shared units and specially adapted accommodation for older people and people with physical disabilities.

In addition to working collaboratively with professionals in mental health, Tai Esgyn also works with a range of partners in the Statutory, Independent and Third Sectors.

All Tai Esgyn staff have expertise in the field of mental health.

Tai Esgyn was awarded **Investor in People** status in 2008 and in 2009 won **Learning Organisation of the Year at the Blaenau Gwent Social Care Partnership Achievement Awards**.

About Our Services

Tai Esgyn provides a wide range of support and accommodation services for adults:

- **Intensive support and housing services for people stepping down from low-secure facilities**
- **Intensive support and housing services for people repatriating from out-of-county residential placements**
- **24/7 supported housing and tenancy support**
- **Specialist support and housing for older people within extra-care housing**
- **A wide range of floating support services**
- **Domiciliary care services including personal care**
- **Palliative care**
- **Support with dementia**
- **Rehabilitation and support for substance misusers**
- **Support at home for people who have an acquired brain injury**
- **Respite care at home/ support to go on holiday**
- **Support for families and services for carers.**



Working with People to get on with Life

The range of support provided varies in intensity with a flexibility that responds to what is needed; this can include support 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

In addition to WAG-funded Supporting People contracts, Tai Esgyn provides services which are commissioned and funded directly by local authority community care streams, local health commissioners as continuing health care and individual services via direct payments and private contracts. Whatever the level of need, Tai Esgyn can offer a response – from a one-off request to accompany a person to a social event to a three year contract for intensive support.
